

## TWO MINUTE CASE STUDY

## Why InfoReady?

We purchased InfoReady way back in 2016. We knew right away it was going be a really fantastic tool for us. The IRB process was something that was really cumbersome for our investigators and so early on, we really wanted to find a way to use the system for that purpose.

## How does InfoReady help?

One of our goals was to simplify the application process for our investigators and a big part of that was how they get applications to us. Originally, they had to print their documents and get signatures through campus mail. We really wanted to eliminate the process of having to go around campus to get an application signed. Being able to take care of the signature process electronically was a huge selling point for us with InfoReady.

Another really nice feature of InfoReady is that if something is wrong with a submission when you first receive it -- maybe it's incomplete, it's missing attachments -- then you can return it to the submitter to make those updates and resubmit.

We also wanted to reduce the effort for reviewers. InfoReady made it really easy for anyone to go into the Reviews tab in their account to access all the documents related to anything that they've approved in the past.

Everything else that we were receiving as submissions to our office, like internal review processes for external grants, internal grant competitions, budget revisions, we were managing were already in InfoReady. We really wanted the consistency so that anyone who was going to submit something to our office would just automatically know this is how it's going to be done. They would know exactly where to go and, and what that process would look like once they started it.

We use InfoReady to store all the records. We just go back into InfoReady if we need to access a record, so it's a completely paperless system for us.

I think InfoReady is probably the most intuitive system there is for doing things like this.
